



Dr. Veselka Djambazova was born in 1961 in Sofia. She finished the English Language School in Sofia during 1979.

Dr. Veselka Djambazova graduated Medicine at the Medical University of Sofia during 1985. From 1985 until 1990 she worked as a physician in three industrial units. In 1990 she started work in the Institute of Hygiene and Occupational Diseases.

Since 2010 Dr. Djambazova is Head of the Department for General and Occupational Diseases and Chronic Intoxications in the Clinic of Occupational Diseases - Sofia.

From 2016 she is an assistant professor in the Department of Occupational Diseases at the Medical Faculty of Sofia, thus conducting seminars and practical exercises on Occupational Diseases of Bulgarian and English language students and trainee doctors.

Dr. Djambazova has three specialties: Internal Medicine, Pneumology and Occupational Diseases. Annually she participates in scientific forums and clinical simposia in the country and abroad, as well as all world congresses in pneumology.

She has participated as a Principal investigator in several clinical trials and has seven scientific publications in the field of lung diseases.

Dr. Djambazova has completed the course for Public Health Management in the faculty of Public Health – Medical University Sofia.
